

Subject: **Flood Situation in River Jhelum at Upstream Mangla Dam**

Reference: Weekly Significant Weather Outlook for Rivers Catchments (From 26 August 2020 to 1 September 2020) No: WF-72/20 by FFD, PMD dated 25 August 2020 (Copy enclosed).

Flood Forecasting Division (FFD), PMD has informed that due to possible convergence of Southeasterly from Bay of Bengal and Southwesterly from Arabian Sea over the upper catchments of Rivers Jhelum, Chenab & Ravi, it is very likely that **CATEGORY-1 (Above 300,000 Cusecs) Flood Situation may arise in RIVER JHELMUM at upstream MANGLA** during 26 to 28 August 2020. All concerned departments are requested to remain **High Alert** and take all precautionary measure to avoid loss of life and property.

> RAINFALL OUTLOOK:

Widespread rain/wind-thundershowers (with few heavy falls) are expected over the upper catchments of Rivers Kabul, Jhelum, Chenab & Ravi along with Kashmir, Islamabad, Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa and Gilgit-Baltistan.

> FLOOD SITUATION IN MAJOR RIVERS:

Due to possible convergence of Southeasterly from Bay of Bengal and Southwesterly from Arabian Sea over the upper catchments of Rivers Jhelum, Chenab & Ravi, it is very likely that CATEGORY-1 Flood situation may arise in **RIVER JHELUM** at upstream **MANGLA** during 26th to 28th August 2020.
